Words from Wayne

Why are so many men, women and children too busy to stop and worship God on a weekly basis? Why do so many good people invest so much of their time, talent and money worshiping hobbies, entertainers and sports figures? Why does humanity prefer that which is temporary over and against worshiping the ONE who is eternal? The sad reality and the Biblical answer to these questions is deception.

What were those words Jesus said in response to the evil one who tried to deceive him by promising all the authority and splendor of the world if he would only change the focus of his worship? The fourth chapter of Luke's Gospel reflects our Savior and Lord responding to such deception with God's Word, "***It is written: Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.***" An essential element in the life of a disciple is a commitment to worshiping God. It is essential to a disciple's life because it was essential to Jesus!

Combating deception, the Presbyterian Book of Order maintains, "*Christian worship joyfully ascribes all praise and honor, glory and power to the triune God... In worship the faithful offer themselves to God and are equipped for God's service in the world*" (W1.1001). Similarly, Pastor Michael W. Foss wrote, "*Worship is about the coming of God...In worship, people who long to connect with the Spirit can heal their heart's hunger.*" (Real Faith For Real Life, pg. 39). Yes, in worship people connect with God and they are transformed and empowered to experience life as God intended.

With these thoughts in mind, I wanted to encourage you to grow as disciples this Lenten season by being truly committed to worshiping God. On Sunday mornings come to worship with hearts open and ready to encounter the ONE who loves you like no other. Further, you can grow as a disciple by experiencing the worship that takes place during one of **LSPC's** Wednesday evening Soup Suppers, which begin at 6:30 p.m.

In closing, I want to remind everyone that **LSPC** is ***Living to Share the Peace of Christ*** because our mission is to help make and grow disciples. One way we help accomplish such an important mission is through a commitment to worshiping God! WOW, what an honor! What a privilege!! What a purpose!!!

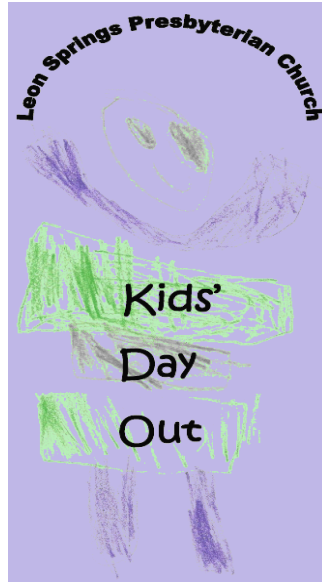
